

2026 Titus County Fair Market Steer Rules

Superintendent – Jarred Conroy

1. Tag-in steers at Stone Livestock Commission from 8:00 - 9:00 a.m., Saturday, April 18, 2026.
2. The judge will select the sale order based on the General Livestock Rules.
3. Steers will be ear-tagged at tag in.
4. All steers must be dehorned before the show.
5. Any steer can be shown provided they weigh a minimum of 1,000 lbs. at time of show check-in
6. Wild or unruly steers that cannot be shown/led will not be sold or exhibited.
7. If an exhibitor misses the original tag in date, they will have until Sunday, April 19, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. to contact Show Superintendent for late weigh-in, with an additional \$25 fee.
8. Night tie out will be done in designated area ONLY.
9. All steers shown in the Titus County Fair Steer Show will be a slick-shorn to no more than 1/4 inch over entire body, except for switch, prior to weigh-in. During weigh-in at the fair, all steers will be inspected for unshaven hair. If touch-ups are needed the exhibitor will have until the show begins to complete, otherwise those steers will be disqualified.
10. Exhibitor must follow the Titus County Fair Junior Show general rules.
